

**RECORD OF DISCUSSIONS OF THE MEETING TAKEN BY MEMBER (PLANNING) CEA ON 6<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2010 TO REVIEW OF INPUT DATA AVAILABILITY FOR 18<sup>TH</sup> ELECTRIC POWER SURVEY (EPS) OF INDIA.**

Member (Planning), CEA took a meeting to review the position regarding availability of input data for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS of the country. The meeting was attended by Members/Representatives from the States of Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Delhi, UT of Chandigarh, Karnataka, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh and Tripura. The representatives of the States of Nagaland, Mizoram & Sikkim could not attend the meeting. The list of participants is given at **Annexure**.

Member (Planning), CEA welcomed the participants and mentioned that the objective of meeting is to review the status of the availability of input data required for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS and the states which could not attend the Ist Meeting of EPSC held in August, 2010 and the states which have yet to constitute working groups and initiate the process of coordination with various DISCOMs for submission of data have been invited for this meeting. He mentioned that State Governments/TRANSCO are required to designate a Nodal Officer for coordination with the DMLF Division, CEA and constitute working groups with representatives from concerned DISCOMs who have to provide the input data for EPS. He mentioned that Electric Power Survey is an important exercise which provides vital input for planning the capacity addition and formulating the perspective plans for power development in the country. He added that as per the schedule finalized by EPSC in the Ist meeting, the input data was to be submitted by end of November, 2010 but some of the states like, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka and North-East Region states could not participate in the meeting. It is, therefore, important that inter-action be done by these states with concerned DISCOMs and CEA so as to ensure that the requisite data is furnished in a period of one month. Member (Planning) indicated that Partial End Use Method (PEUM) is to be adopted for this 18<sup>th</sup> EPS and its results are to be validated by econometric model. He informed that working group on power is being set up very shortly for which results of power survey would provide a vital input. He mentioned that some of the states may be having certain difficulties in understanding the exact requirement or may have any queries in compiling information in the prescribed proformae, such states can contact DMLF Division, CEA for any clarifications after the meeting or subsequently can also visit CEA for acquainting themselves with the requirements of input data for EPS. With these remarks, he asked Director, DMLF Division, CEA to make a presentation on the status of 18<sup>th</sup> EPS.

Director, DMLF Division, CEA made a power point presentation and outlined the background of power surveys undertaken by CEA, methodology adopted and results of the survey vis-a-vis actual demand, etc. It was informed that most of the states have already constituted the working groups for submission of the data which is to be analysed and processed to determine its adequacy and reliability. He added that preliminary forecast would be undertaken by DMLF Division in co-ordination with concerned Regional Power Survey Offices (RPSOs) and the same would be discussed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC which could be held in the mid of February, 2011.

CE, DMLF Division, CEA informed that scope of 18<sup>th</sup> EPS has been substantially enlarged which would cover separate power survey for Mega cities viz. the cities having a population of more than 50 lakhs and National Capital Region (NCR). He indicated that the representatives of NCT had participated in the 1st meeting but they have yet to initiate action for coordinating among the various DISCOMs. Since the data in respect of NCT is of vital importance, as such action needs to be taken by Delhi TRANSCO to expedite supply of the same. He informed that input data has already been furnished by Tripura State Electricity Corporation Limited (TSECL) and the same would be analysed and discussed for any further details or clarifications.

Thereafter, Member (Planning), CEA invited the Members/Representatives to express their views and suggestions and their action plan for submitting the input data for power survey.

The views/suggestions of the states/organizations are outlined below:-

#### **National Capital Territory (NCT) Delhi:**

The representative of Delhi TRANSCO indicated constraints for coordinating among all the DISCOMs. He stated that they have already initiated action but the response of DISCOM is not very encouraging. He, however, assured that Delhi TRANSCO will make vigorous efforts and provide the data by mid of January, 2011.

Joint Director (Director), NCR Planning Board mentioned that NCR Region covers areas lying in the states of NCT Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana and Rajasthan. He mentioned that a report "Regional Plan 2021 of NCR Region" have already been prepared by NCR Planning Board which also covers plan of action and phasing of implementation of strategies/policies/proposals for development of power. A copy of the report was provided during the meeting. He added that another report entitled "Functional Plan for Power 2021 for NCR" is under finalization and a copy of the same would be provided to CEA

very shortly. He suggested that CEA may coordinate with concerned states for obtaining the district-wise input data for NCR Region. In reply to this, Member (Planning) indicated that the projections/forecast by the NCR states needs be realistic and comparable to NCT for which NCR Planning Board would require to look into the adequacies of the forecast made by states so that a realistic projection could be made by CEA as part of 18<sup>th</sup> EPS.

**Jammu & Kashmir:**

Representative of Jammu & Kashmir indicated that they are having constraints in compiling the information and requested that the formats for input data may be provided in Excel form. He sought time up to end of January, 2011 for compiling the data because of various problems and assured to furnish the data by the end of January, 2011.

**Punjab:**

Chief Engineer (Planning), Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (PSPCL) informed that due to unbundling of Punjab State Electricity Board, the action for constituting working group and submission of data is to be taken by Punjab State Power Transmission Corporation. He handed over the data relating to sector-wise energy consumption as available with the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited. He suggested that CEA may write to Punjab Power Transmission Corporation for additional data required for EPS.

**Karnataka:**

The representative of Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Limited (KPTCL) indicated that a Nodal Officer for coordinating with CEA would be designated very shortly. He assured that working group would be constituted and the input data would be furnished within the schedule period viz. mid of January, 2011. He added that KPTCL is not fully familiar with the requirements of CEA. CE, DMLF Division suggested that KPTCL may contact Regional Power Survey Office (South), Bangaluru for any query/clarifications regarding data.

**Assam:**

Chief Engineer, Assam State Electricity Board mentioned that they have already designated Nodal Officer and the requisite data would be compiled and submitted to CEA by mid of January, 2011.

**Arunachal Pradesh:**

The State of Arunachal Pradesh was represented by Superintending Engineer of Regional Office, Delhi. He indicated that data requirement of CEA would be communicated to Government of Arunachal Pradesh and Shri G. Bagra, Secretary (Power) would be requested to designate a Nodal Officer. He assured that necessary action would be taken by

Government of Arunachal Pradesh for providing the data by January, 2011 to CEA.

**Meghalaya:**

The representative of Meghalaya Energy Corporation Limited (MECL) informed that the formats for input data may be provided in the Excel Form so that necessary action for compiling of data may be taken up. He added that they are already on the job and the data would be provided as per schedule.

**Manipur:**

The representative of Electricity Department, Manipur mentioned that the format may be provided in Excel Sheet and assured that the requisite data would be made available as per schedule.

**Tripura:**

The representative of Tripura State Electricity Corporation Limited stated that input data have already been provided to CEA. He added that certain query/clarification relating to data need to be discussed with CEA and the additional remaining data/information would be submitted expeditiously.

**Chandigarh (UT):**

The representative of Chandigarh UT mentioned that the requisite data would be made available as per schedule.

After discussions, following decisions were taken:-

- All States/UTs to take action to designate nodal officer and constitute Working Groups and provide the input data by mid January, 2011 (except Jammu & Kashmir which is to provide data by end of June, 2011).  
(Action: concerned States/Chandigarh, UT)
- Scrutiny of data for reliability, adequacy and consultation with states by mid February, 2011.  
(Action: DMLF Division/RPSOs)
- Preparation of Region-wise/State-wise draft forecast by concerned RPSOs and submission to DMLF Division, CEA by end of February, 2011.  
(Action: concerned RPSOs)

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
