**RECORD OF DISCUSSIONS OF THE MEETING HELD ON 17<sup>TH</sup> FEB.,2011  
AT GUWAHATI TO REVIEW THE AVAILABILITY OF INPUT DATA IN  
RESPECT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION STATES/UTILITIES FOR 18<sup>TH</sup>  
ELECTRIC POWER SURVEY OF THE COUNTRY.**

A Regional level meeting for North Eastern Region was taken by Shri Major Singh, Chief Engineer (DMLF), CEA & Member Secretary of 18<sup>th</sup> Electric Power Survey Committee at Hotel Ginger Guwahati to review the status of input data for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS. The meeting was attended by representatives of Assam, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Tripura and Nagaland. No representative from Arunachal Pradesh was present during the meeting.

Initiating the discussions, Shri Major Singh, Chief Engineer, DMLF & Member Secretary to 18<sup>th</sup> EPS Committee thanked Assam State Power Distribution Company Ltd. (APDCL) for hosting the meeting and for overwhelming response of states/utilities in the meeting. He mentioned that objective of the meeting is to review the position of submission of input data by various states/utilities of N.E Region and also to clarify any doubts/queries of states on the input data for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS. He indicated that a review meeting was earlier taken by Member (Planning) CEA on 06.12.2010 to discuss the data requirements for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS with NE Region States. He added that the results of 17<sup>th</sup> EPS indicate the forecast upto 11<sup>th</sup> Plan period viz. 2011-12. As such the forecast for 18<sup>th</sup> EPS has to be finalized in a very compressed time frame. He further mentioned that so far Tripura, Assam, & Mizoram States have given some data and other states are still in the process of collecting the information by coordination with various DISCOMs. He requested that the representatives may discuss their constraints or doubts in this regard. He informed that the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC is proposed to be held in the 1st week of March, 2011. The EPSC would discuss the draft forecast reports of various states during the next meeting. Therefore, it would be appropriate that the input data is furnished by all States on priority so that the draft reports could be prepared by CEA.

After these remarks of Chief Engineer (DMLF), a presentation was made by Shri S. Biswas, Director (DMLF).

In the presentation, Shri S. Biswas outlined the history of EPSC, various methodologies adopted for earlier Power Surveys, National Electricity Policy (2005) objectives considered for 17<sup>th</sup> EPS, the comparison between actuals and projection of 17<sup>th</sup> EPS and action plan for completing the survey. The suggestions and the queries of the representatives of various States/Utilities on various aspects were also discussed during the presentation.

After the presentation, the Member Secretary, 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC invited the States representatives to explain the action being taken for furnishing the data to CEA.

### **Tripura:**

The input data furnished by Tripura was examined by CEA. CEA explained that there was mismatch of data for few years. A preliminary forecast on the basis of available data was handed over to representative of Tripura. It was requested that missing data may be furnished, as well as comments if any on the draft forecast may be given by the end of Feb.,2011.

### **Assam:**

The input data submitted by Assam was generally in order. The representative informed that segregation of rural & urban consumption details may not be possible. However, the projections In the domestic and commercial category was slightly on higher side. The details in respect of industries having demand more than 1 MW is to be furnished by Assam by the end of Feb.,2011.

### **Nagaland :**

The state is yet to take up the compilation of requisite input data. The representatives of Nagaland raised various queries on compilation of data and necessary guidelines were given to them for the same. The extracts of the 17<sup>th</sup> EPS pertaining to Nagaland were given to representative. A copy of the report of 17<sup>th</sup> EPS was requested by them and same has been sent separately. They were requested to furnish the data expeditiously so that draft forecast could be submitted during next meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> EPS.

### **Mizoram :**

The input data submitted by Mizoram has been examined and it was indicated that projection was on very higher side which was not realistic. Moreover, in certain categories there was mismatch of data which needs to be corrected by Mizoram. The queries of the representatives of Mizoram were clarified and they were requested to expedite the submission of corrected data.

### **Manipur:**

The representatives of Manipur showed the data/projections being done by the State. On perusal it was noticed that data is unreliable and does not indicate the realistic details. Manipur state was requested to correct the data along with other details which were explained in details during the meeting.

## **Meghalaya:**

Meghalaya is yet to take up action for compiling the input data. The representatives of Meghalaya raised various queries on compilation of data and necessary guidelines were given to them for the same. They were requested to furnish the data expeditiously so that draft forecast could be submitted during next meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC.

After discussions with the above states, Member Secretary, 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC urged Meghalaya & Nagaland to start compiling the data and requested all the states to furnish the data expeditiously as per guidelines given during the meeting. He said that the states may approach CEA or RPSO (East) for any further clarifications and send data by email also. He added that since Arunachal Pradesh could not attend any of the meetings so far they will be separately requested to attend meeting at CEA, New Delhi. Member Secretary thanked the participants for active participation in the meeting and requested them to submit the input data so that the same could be analyzed and draft reports could be deliberated in the next meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> EPSC. He again thanked APDCL for making excellent arrangements for hosting the meeting at a short notice.
