RECORD OF DISCUSSIONS OF THE MEETING HELD ON 4TH FEB.,2011 TO REVIEW THE AVAILABILITY OF INPUT DATA IN RESPECT OF SOUTHERN REGION STATES/UTILITIES FOR 18TH ELECTRIC POWER SURVEY OF THE COUNTRY.

A Regional level meeting for Southern Region was taken by Shri Major Singh, Chief Engineer (DMLF), CEA and Member Secretary of 18th Electric Power Survey Committee at KPTCL, Conference Room, Kaveri Bhawan, Bangalore to review the status of input data for 18th EPS. The meeting was attended by representatives of State TRANSCOs, DISCOMs, Nodal Officers of states/utilities.

The list of participants is given in the Annexure.

Inaugurating the meeting, Shri Major Singh, Chief Engineer, DMLF and Member Secretary to 18th EPS Committee thanked KPTCL for hosting the meeting and for overwhelming response of states/utilities in the meeting. He mentioned that objective of the meeting is to review the position of submission of input data by various states/utilities of Southern Region and also to clarify any doubts/queries on the input data. He added that the results of 17th EPS cover the forecast upto 11th Plan period viz. 2011-12. As such the forecast for 18th EPS has to be finalized in a very compressed time frame. He further mentioned that the most of the states of Southern Region are already in the process of collecting the information by coordination with various DISCOMs but the final compiled information as per prescribed proforma is yet to be submitted to CEA. He stated that 18th EPS would also include forecast of Mega cities (population above 50 lakhs) as such separate data in respect of Hyderabad, Chennai & Bangalore would also be needed by CEA. He requested that the representatives may explain their constraints, if any, in this regard so that CEA may consider other options, available for utilizing the available data. He informed that the 2nd meeting of 18th EPSC is proposed to be held in the 1st week of March, 2011. The EPSC would discuss the draft forecast reports of various states during the meeting. Therefore, it would be appropriate that the input data is furnished by all States on priority so that the draft reports could be prepared by CEA. After these remarks, Chief Engineer (DMLF), a presentation was made by Shri S. Biswas, Director (DMLF).

In the presentation, Shri S. Biswas explained outlined the history of EPSC, various methodology adopted by previous Power Surveys, National Electricity Policy (2005) objectives considered for 17th EPS, Methodology adopted for 17th EPS, the comparison between actuals and projection of 17th EPS and action plan for carrying out the survey. The suggestions and the queries of the representatives of various State/Utilities on various aspects were also discussed during the presentation.

After the presentation, the Member Secretary, 18th EPSC invited States/Utilities/concerned Organization to explain the action being taken for furnishing the data to CEA.

Andhra Pradesh:

The representatives of Andhra Pradesh informed that they have submitted most of the input data and forecast in respect of AP State and Hyderabad City. The deficiencies observed by RPSO, CEA, Bangalore in the input data furnished by them were discussed. The representatives assured that the correct data incorporating the observations of CEA would be furnished very shortly to CEA.

Karnataka :

The representatives of various DISCOMs in Karnataka mentioned that there is no uniform pattern in the consumption trend of various categories and shortages vary for each DISCOM. They requested that there should be some benchmark for incorporating the affect of Demand Side Management (DSM) and the trend of growth to be adopted. The representatives also mentioned that the complete information in respect of HT industries with more than 1 MW may be very difficult to compile and the data for industries having demand more than 7 MW would be furnished. The Member Secretary, 18th EPSC requested KPTCL to coordinate with all DISCOMs and ensure that the requisite data is furnished to CEA by end of February, 2011.

Kerala :

The representatives of KSEB informed that the data has already been submitted. RPSO (South) mentioned that there are certain deficiencies in the data provided by KSEB which would need to be discussed separately to them. Member Secretary, 18th EPSC requested KSEB to incorporate the observations and discuss with RPSO and ensure that the data is submitted by 15th February, 2011.

Puducherry :

The representative of Puducherry Electricity Department informed that the input data with forecast has already been submitted to CEA by mail. He added that the data in respect of certain industries which yet to be furnished would be pursued and submitted by 15th Feb.,2011.

Tamil Nadu:

The representatives of TNEB informed that he has submitted the input data to RPSO today. He added that any additional information or clarifications of RPSO (South) would be replied on priority. He assured that the data in respect of Chennai is being compiled separately by coordination with the concerned Utility and would be submitted subsequently.

After the discussions, Member Secretary asked Director (DMLF) and officers of RPSO (S) to hold separate discussions with states and explain the deficiencies observed in the input data and coordinate for preparing the draft Report of Forecast. Member Secretary thanked the participants for active participation in the meeting and requested them to submit the corrected input data by email to RPSO (South) and CEA so that the same could be analyzed and draft reports could be deliberated in the next meeting of 18th EPSC. He again thanked KPTCL for making excellent arrangements for the meeting at a short notice.
